Call for sites – accompanying notes

What is a call for sites?

The call for sites is an important opportunity for all organisations and individuals to suggest land in Woking Borough for development or protection. This will feed into the Site Allocations Development Plan Document (DPD) which will allocate sites for specific use.

What is the Site Allocations Development Plan Document?

The Site Allocations Development Plan Document (DPD) will be part of the Development Plan for Woking. It will establish site-specific planning policies, allocate sites for development and protect areas such as open spaces. Site allocations will be illustrated on the Proposals Map.

When will the call for sites take place?

The call for sites will begin in June 2012. Please note that there will be further opportunities to submit sites for consideration in the autumn.

How should I respond to the call for sites?

We would like to hear from you if you wish us to consider a site or sites within Woking Borough to be allocated for development or protection. Sites need not necessarily be in your ownership and could be allocated for a wide range of uses. For each site being put forward, an initial site assessment form should be completed and accompanied by a map showing a clear site boundary. There is no minimum or maximum site size.

What will happen when my response has been submitted?

Submitted sites will be complied and be subject to detailed assessment, including sustainability appraisal, to evaluate whether they should be taken forward through the Site Allocations DPD. Sites taken forward will be illustrated on the Proposals Map.

What happens next?

Public consultation will take place on the Site Allocations DPD in late 2012.
