STATEMENT OF ADOPTION FOR THE WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL LOCAL DEVELOPMENT DOCUMENTS

PARKING STANDARDS SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT (SPD)

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012 Regulation 14 – Adoption of Supplementary Planning Documents

- a) The Parking Standards Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was adopted by the Council and came into effect on 5 April 2018. The SPD defines the appropriate number of parking spaces to serve various types of development across the borough.
- b) The SPD replaces the existing Parking Standards and provides detailed guidance for the application of specific policies of the Core Strategy. It does not introduce any new policies. It is a material consideration in the determination of planning applications.
- c) Any person aggrieved by the Parking Standards SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the document. Such an application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
